

# Understanding the 78 Tarot Cards

The tarot deck is divided into two main categories: the Major Arcana and the Minor Arcana. Each category serves a unique purpose in your readings, representing different aspects of life and experiences.

## Major Arcana

The Major Arcana consists of 22 cards that signify profound life events and spiritual lessons. Here's the complete list of the Major Arcana cards along with their simplified meanings:

- The Fool: New beginnings; spontaneity; adventure.

- Justice: Fairness; truth; law.
- The Hanged Man: Sacrifice; release; new perspectives.
- Death: Endings; transformation; transition.
- Temperance: Balance; moderation; harmony.
- The Devil: Addiction; materialism; restriction.
- The Tower: Sudden change; chaos; revelation.
- The Star: Hope; inspiration; serenity.
- The Moon: Illusion; intuition; the subconscious.
- The Sun: Joy; success; positivity.
- Judgement: Reflection; reckoning; awakening.
- The World: Completion; fulfillment; achievement.

## Minor Arcana

The Minor Arcana consists of 56 cards divided into four suits: Cups, Pentacles, Swords, and Wands. Each suit represents different areas of life. Here's a breakdown of the Minor Arcana cards:

### Cups

- Ace of Cups: New relationships; emotional fulfillment.
- Two of Cups: Partnership; harmony; connection.
- Three of Cups: Friendship; celebration; community.
- Four of Cups: Apathy; contemplation; reevaluation.
- Five of Cups: Loss; grief; focusing on the negative.
- Six of Cups: Nostalgia; childhood memories; innocence.
- Seven of Cups: Choices; daydreaming; illusion.
- Eight of Cups: Abandonment; seeking deeper meaning.
- Nine of Cups: Contentment; satisfaction; emotional well-being.
- Ten of Cups: Happiness; family; emotional stability.

### Pentacles

- Ace of Pentacles: New financial opportunities; prosperity.
- Two of Pentacles: Balancing finances; adaptability.
- Three of Pentacles: Teamwork; collaboration; skill development.
- Four of Pentacles: Control; stability; resistance to change.
- Five of Pentacles: Hardship; financial loss; insecurity.
- Six of Pentacles: Generosity; charity; sharing wealth.
- Seven of Pentacles: Patience; long-term view; investment.
- Eight of Pentacles: Skill mastery; diligence; quality work.
- Nine of Pentacles: Independence; luxury; self-sufficiency.
- Ten of Pentacles: Legacy; financial security; family bonds.

### Swords

- Ace of Swords: Clarity; new ideas; breakthroughs.
- Two of Swords: Indecision; choices; blocked emotions.
- Three of Swords: Heartbreak; sorrow; betrayal.
- Four of Swords: Rest; recovery; contemplation.
- Five of Swords: Conflict; tension; betrayal.
- Six of Swords: Transition; moving on; recovery.
- Seven of Swords: Deception; strategy; stealth.
- Eight of Swords: Restriction; feeling trapped; self-imposed limitations.
- Nine of Swords: Anxiety; fear; nightmares.
- Ten of Swords: Endings; betrayal; loss.

### Wands

- Ace of Wands: Inspiration; new opportunities; growth.
- Two of Wands: Planning; future possibilities; decision-making.
- Three of Wands: Expansion; foresight; exploration.
- Four of Wands: Celebration; community; homecoming.
- Five of Wands: Competition; conflict; rivalry.
- Six of Wands: Success; recognition; achievement.
- Seven of Wands: Challenge; perseverance; standing your ground.
- Eight of Wands: Swift action; movement; progress.
- Nine of Wands: Resilience; stamina; persistence.
- Ten of Wands: Burden; responsibility; stress.

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
